Packages

#1 - \$1,950.00

This is a six hour package that includes 2 manned cameras at your ceremony, as well as your reception. The video is shot with HD camcorders while the sound is captured both live, as well as with wireless microphones (during the ceremony). Your final product will be on DVD or Blu-Ray Disc.

#2 - \$2,350.00

This package is an 8 hour version of package one. This is the most popular package, because it is about how long a wedding day is (if you were to start from getting ready until the final cutting of the cake at the reception). It's a great time capsule of your whole wedding day experience. Package 2 comes with two copies of the final product.

#3 - \$2,750.00

This is the massive 10 hour package! It comes with 3 DVD copies of the final product. As you get closer to your wedding day and you're working on your itinerary... and it does not fit into a regular 8 hour day, you might want to bump up to this package. This day will not happen again, so be sure to allow enough time to capture it all!

Half Price

The 3-Hour Option - \$1,000.00

This is a custom package you can opt for that is just 3 hours long. It's great for people who want a professional HD videographer to cover the ceremony and some of the moments preceding and following it. For \$1000.00 (half of the 6 hour package) you'd have your event shot on HD video (1 camera) and your end product would be on DVD with a menu page, chapters, and your input on music selections.

The Shoot-Only Option

The other way to be creative with your finances is to just have your wedding shot for now and have it edited on a later date, this would cut the price of any package you choose IN HALF (not including the 3 hour option). You'd receive the master digital video tapes at the end of the night. There are 2 cameras, and 2 operators on this package and it will be shot on HD. In the future you can have Walter edit the video for the other half of the package price.. or you can have your friend put it together for free. What a friend!

Please note that Walter cannot guarantee that he will personally be able to shoot the these half price packages if a full price package books on the same day.. in that case his assistant/s will shoot the wedding and Walter would catch up with them at the beginning or end of the event if possible.

Extra Goodies

"Childhood Memory" video - \$250

If you would like a montage of your favorite photographs on video that follow your lives from childhood to dating to current day, it is available. This can be used at the reception and/or be put onto your final wedding video tape. A video of this nature is about 5-10 minutes long.

Rehearsal - \$600

Why not have your rehearsal filmed and turned into a fun montage? Everybody is a lot more relaxed and candid a day or 2 before the wedding.

Projection not included.

Final Production

The final product is provided on a DVD disc. Once it has been edited, you will have a very cool wedding video running approximately 60-90 minutes in length. The disc includes a menu page and chapter selections.

The goal is to have a beautiful/fun time capsule that you and your friends can enjoy in one sitting, not a 6 hour documentary. Everything is edited and mixed on a digital editing system which creates seamless dissolves, perfect title graphics and super clean sound.

Basically, the final product is crystal clear. There is no 'generation loss'.

Demo DVD

Please contact Walter if you would like a demo reel free of charge. He feels it is important for you to see the quality of what your wedding video will be like on your own home entertainment system, not on a computer screen. You will see a wide range of styles represented on this 15 minute video, from comical to beautiful. Walter's goal is to custom make each wedding video reflect the tastes and styles of each couple, not to try different approaches just to be different.

Approach

Walter believes that this is YOUR wedding day, and not his. In other words, he remains low profile while also being at the right place at the right time. It is his preference to capture all of your wedding day moments as they naturally occur – NOT, for example, killing a moment by rushing up to it with a blinding light source and a microphone.

A specialty of his is capturing candid moments with an approach like that of a photo-journalist. Have you ever watched a video where people look really awkward and self-conscious because a stranger is standing there videotaping them and asking them questions? This will not be the case with Walter. He knows how to read people well and has a great eye for detail.

One thing that brides and grooms especially appreciate about his videos is that he ends up capturing things and incidents that very few people noticed during the wedding day.

Biography

Walter Pawluk has been shooting film and video for over 18 years now because it is a passion of his. After being accepted into the film program at the Pasadena Art Center College of Design, his skills flourished as he experimented with film making, commercial advertising, and music videos. While still in school, he won 2 golden Clio awards for his commercial work for Levi's and Conroy's Flowers.

He started work immediately in the commercial industry directing spots primarily in New York and Los Angeles. Having worked with some of the finest creative agencies, and film crews, Walter has developed the ability not only to communicate well with others, but to read situations as they unfold, making the most of productions that sometimes have a life of their own.

While he is still involved in the commercial industry, and a current Director's Guild member, Walter has acquired the technology to shoot, direct, and edit his own work which has opened up a wide array of film-making and video-taping opportunities. This ability found its way to his friend's wedding in 2001 where he was encouraged to shoot and edit the wedding day 'however he wanted to,' what followed was a fantastic documentary of this wonderful day that was both funny and touching, beautiful yet candid and spontaneous. He found that in a world of mostly flat, mass-produced wedding videos, there were people who wanted more... a video that was unique and custom made, shot by someone versed in film making that really paid attention to details and nuances, and yet, was just plain fun!

From the early days of borrowing his mom's super 8 mm camera, to directing commercials across the United States for clients such as McDonalds, Toyota, Geffen Records, and BlockBuster Video, one thing remains the same - story telling.
